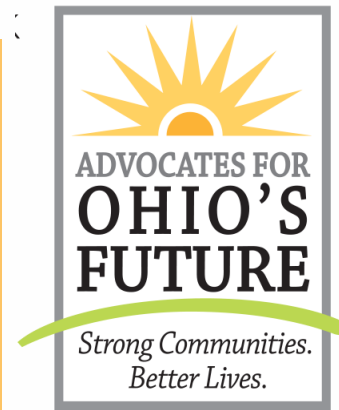


# What Is Issue 1?

## Current vs. Proposed Constitutional Amendment Process



### Current

Signatures required from  
**44** counties

---

In any one county, signatures must equal at least **5 percent of the total vote in the last gubernatorial election**

---

Statewide total number of signatures must equal at least **10 percent** of the total vote in the last gubernatorial election

---

If signatures determined to be insufficient, **petitioners have 10 additional days** to collect and file additional signatures

---

Requires **majority of voters** (50 percent plus 1 vote) to approve to pass

### Issue 1

Signatures required from  
**all 88** counties

---

**No change**

**No change**

---

If signatures determined to be insufficient, **petitioners must start process over again**

---

Requires **60 percent of voters** to approve to pass

The Ohio constitutional amendment process is one of only **two avenues** for citizens to enact direct legal change, and the only way to enact laws not passed by the state legislature. **GET OUT AND VOTE!**
