Bishop Gregory V. Palmer

Gregory Vaughn Palmer serves as the episcopal leader of the Ohio West Area of The United Methodist Church. Currently, he is a member of the Standing Committee on Central Conference Matters and chair of the Comprehensive Africa Plan. He also is a board member of several organizations, including The United Methodist Publishing House, Methodist Theological School in Ohio, United Theological Seminary, OhioHealth, and numerous others.



Rep. Jay Edwards

State Representative Jay Edwards is serving his fourth term as state representative. He represents the 94th Ohio House District. Rep. Edwards is the Chairman of the House Finance Committee, which is responsible for producing the state's main operating budget and capital budget. He also serves on the House Rules and Reference Committee.



Rep. Bride Rose Sweeney

Rep. Sweeney is a three-term Democratic member of the Ohio House for District 16, Ranking Member of the Ohio House Finance Committee and on the Finance Subcommittee on Infrastructure and the American Rescue Plan. When she was elected in 2018, Sweeney became the first woman ever to represent her district at the Statehouse and the youngest Democratic member of the 133rd Ohio General Assembly.
